

COMMISSIONERS COURT  
REGULAR SESSION  
DECEMBER 28, 1999

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day with all Commissioners present and Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as presented.

OLD BUSINESS:

7465 'Discuss and possibly take action on Award of a Construction Contract for 1998 Texas Community Development Program Water & Sewer System Improvement:' Steve Kerbow with Kerbow & Assoc. Consulting Inc. & Eddie Daniels-Engineer stated open bids had been received and ask the Court for additional time. The Court agreed to table this item-placed on OLD BUSINESS for next court meeting.

County Attorney: Add Joel Durrett as Asst C.A.-Grade 11 (\$32,535 a year), effective 1-1-2000.


196th District Court: Terminate Jerry Tidwell, effective 12-22-99.
