

COMMISSIONERS COURT
REGULAR SESSION
September 10, 2001

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day with all Commissioners present and Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes from the Budget Workshop on August 14, 2001, Regular Session on August 27, 2001 and Budget Workshop on August 27, 2001 were approved as presented. The Court noted a change in the wording on #8072 of August 13, 2001.

8099 On the motion by Phillip Martin, second by Kenneth Thornton, the court approved the change.

NEW BUSINESS:

8100 On the motion by Allen Martin, second by Ralph Green, the Court approved the high bids received (13) which we “struck off” to the County of Hunt and have been submitted to the resale with minimum pre-approved by the Commissioners Court.

8101 On the motion by Green, second by Allen Martin, the court approved high bid received on resale properties (40), which were “struck off” to other taxing jurisdictions.

8102 On the motion by Allen Martin, second by Phillip Martin, the Court approved request of Tax Collector – Joyce Barrow to publish listing of delinquent business/personal property accounts. For: Allen Martin, Phillip Martin, and Ralph Green. Against: Thornton. Motion passes.

8103 On the motion by Allen Martin, second by Phillip Martin, the Court approved court order, prohibiting the keeping of wild animals, pursuant to Chapter 240, Local Government Code and creating a criminal penalty. See attachment. Commissioner Green ask who would police this item, Commissioner Phillip Martin stated Parks and Wildlife Dept. and Sheriffs Dept.

8104 On the motion by Judge Bobbitt, second by Green, the Court approved the appointment of June Hill to the Hunt County Child Protective Services Board due to Pat Ellis’s term ending.

8105 On the motion by Allen Martin, second by Phillip Martin, the court approved request of FEC to construct electrical power distribution facilities along and across CR 4614 in PCT 4 with the usual stipulations.

8106 On the motion by Phillip Martin, second by Allen Martin, the Court approved request of FEC to construct electrical power facilities along and across CR 3203, 3609, and 3622 in PCT 3 with the usual stipulations.

8107 On the motion of Green, second by Thornton, the court approved the request of FEC to construct electrical power distribution facilities along and across CR 2538, 2604 and 2718 in PCT 2 with the usual stipulations.

8108 On the motion by Green, second by Thornton, the Court approved the preliminary plat for Cedar Estates in PCT 2 presented by Jerry Wisdom. Agreement was made that restrictions will be on the final plat.

8109 On the motion by Phillip Martin second by Green, the court approved sealed bid of \$175,000.00 for building registered with the Federal Land Bank, the old Texas Employment Commission located on Stonewall Street which has approximately 4,000 square feet.

8110 On the motion by Green, second by Allen Martin, the Court accepted bids received from Tyler Asphalt and Buster Paving for asphalt hot and cold. Bids on file in the Personnel Office.

8111 On the motion by Thornton, second by Phillip Martin, the Court approved bid for brush cutters from Bane Machinery for \$63,490.00 each - delivered to precinct barn for all precincts. Bid on file in the Personnel Office.

8112 On the motion by Judge Bobbitt, second by Thornton, the Court authorized Juvenile Protection to utilize the old Sheriffs Office Administration Area (CJC) and will now be called Juvenile Probation. Alan Brown briefed the Court concerning the completion of the renovation of this area. All renovation funded by using the Availability Incentive Block Grant Funding in the amount of \$25,000.00. This area hopefully will be available for occupancy by next week.

HEAR AND DISCUSS REPORTS:

— Ray Pendley was present asking the Court about the closing of the bridge on CR 3131. Judge Bobbitt advised Mr. Pendley this is a Commissioners item, asking him to talk to his Commissioner after court adjourns.

8113 On the motion by Allen Martin, second by Thornton, the Court approved accounts payable. Judge Bobbitt abstained from the vote.

8114 On the motion by Green, second by Allen Martin, the Court approved line item budget transfers.


STATE OF TEXAS

COUNTY OF HUNT

Order Prohibiting the keeping of
Wild Animals, pursuant to Chapter 240.
Local Government Code and Creating a Criminal Penalty

1. The Commissioners Court hereby determines that wild animals, as defined in this order, are dangerous and in need of control in this county.
2. Wild animals means a lion, tiger, ocelot, cougar, leopards, cheetah, jaguar, bobcat, lynx, serval, caracal, hyena, bear, coyote, jackal, baboon, chimpanzee, orangutans, gorilla, lesser panda, binturong, wolf, ape, elephant, and rhinoceros, or any hybrid of an animal listed in this definition.
3. The keeping of a wild animal in the unincorporated area of this county hereby prohibited, except as otherwise specifically permitted by state of federal law
4. A violation of this order is an offense punishable as a Class C misdemeanor.
5. A violation or threatened violation of this order may be enjoined by as action in district court.
