Resolution

Attack on America



WHEREAS, on September 11, 2001, America was suddenly and brutally attack by foreign terrorists, and;

Be it further resolved, that the governing board of Hunt County supports the President of the United States, as he works with his national security team to defend against additional attacks, and find the perpetrators to bring them to justice, and;

Be it still further resolved, that the governing boards of Hunt County recommends to its citizens to support relief efforts by giving blood at the nearest available blood donation center.
