

**COMMISSIONERS COURT  
REGULAR SESSION**  
*February 24, 2003*

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day with all Commissioners present and Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as presented.

NEW BUSINESS:

**8654** On the motion by Judge Bobbitt, second by Kenneth Thornton, the Court re-approved all current members of the Hunt County Historical Commission due to their request for reappointment. *See Attachment.*

**8655** On the motion by Phillip Martin, second by Jim Latham, the Court approved the Historical Commission's Annual Report presented by Carol Taylor.

— 'Discuss and possibly take action on Local Historical Marker Guidelines presented by Carol Taylor.' The Court noted this information was received by the Court and agreed no action was required. The Court also discussed a State Historical Marker for the Exchange Bank, agreement was made for Ms. Taylor to bring design, cost and wording back to the Court for discussion.

**8656** On the motion by Phillip Martin, second by Jim Latham, the Court approved Proclamation affirming March 2<sup>nd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>, 2003 as "Severe Weather Awareness Week."

— 'Discuss and possibly take action on addition of (1) officer per Constable Precinct to assist with outstanding warrants.' Anthony Lewis and Cullen Smith were present asking the Court for (1) extra deputy for each of their precincts to help serve outstanding warrants and also help with court security. This addition to be compensated solely through fees they are collecting, with no burden to the taxpayers and no extra cost to the County, not asking for additional phone, office, internet, etc. Judge Bobbitt suggested a meeting for all parties involved to allow further discussion on this matter.

**8659** On the motion by Green, second by Martin, the Court approved allocation of contingency funds of up to \$20,000 for renovation of the Old Texas Workforce building for the Adult Probation Office. Judge Bobbitt stated the District Judges have agreed to this plan and the Fire Chief is checking this building.

— ‘Discuss and possibly take action on request of Joyce Barrow – Tax Assessor to close Tax Office March 17, 2003 to allow for office relocation and equipment set up.’ Judge Bobbitt stated the Court acknowledged this move. Kaye Abbott stated they plan to be open for business on Tuesday – March 18, 2003 barring any problems.

— ‘Discuss and possibly take action on request of Joyce Barrow – Tax Assessor to close Tax Office/Mtr. Vehicle Dept. on April 7, 2003 to allow for office relocation and equipment set up.’ Judge Bobbitt stated the Court acknowledged this move. Kaye Abbott stated they plan to be open for business on Tuesday April 8, 2003 barring any problems.
