All Commissioners were present, Judge Joe Bobbitt was out of town, Ralph Green was acting Judge. Present in Court for this meeting were Brian and Jeanette Mott with their daughter stating people speed down this cut thru section of road, their dog has been killed and they are afraid a child might be hurt since several children live in this area. Six property owners presented the Court with a petition stating: Due to the growth in this area, the road has proven to be a danger for all parties listed. This road needs to be used for property owner's access only. Commissioner Green stated this is not a platted subdivision – property lines go to the center of the road.

After much discussion, the public hearing closed at 9:55A.M. Minutes approved this day of April, 2003.

COMMISSIONERS COURT REGULAR SESSION

April 14, 2003

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day with all Commissioners present and Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as presented with change added.

OLD BUSINESS:

— 'Discuss and possibly approve contract with Griffin Security for new system in the Tax Office:' Item dropped from the Agenda, to be placed on Agenda at later date.

NEW BUSINESS:

8690 On the motion by Phillip Martin, second by Jim Latham, the Court approved Resolution proclaiming April 2003 as "Child Abuse Prevention Month" in Hunt County. See Attachment.

8691 On the motion by Martin, second by Latham, the Court approved the Security Procedures for the Hunt County Courthouse and the Tax Office Annex, which defines the different color levels of increase security based on the Risk of Terrorist Acts or Threats.

8692 On the motion by Martin, second by Kenneth Thornton, the Court approved high bids received on Judgment Bid Properties R115352, R52339, R29849 and R29857. See Attachment. Deeds to be filed in Real Property Records.

8696 On the motion by Thornton, second by Martin, the Court approved road upgrade of 2,335' of dirt to rock on CR 1129 in Pct 1. Money has been deposited (\$9,340.00) into Escrow.

8697 On the motion by Latham, second by Martin, the Court approved closure of (approximately 150 yards) of a portion of CR2656 extending from FM 2642 northward to State Hwy 66 due to speeding cars using this as a cut thru. All (6) landowners have signed a Petition requesting this closure. Present in Court on this matter were Bryan and Jeanette Mott, along with their daughter, agreeing to have signs prepared and posted. 8698 On the motion by Green, second by Thornton, the Court approved request of FEC Electric to construct electrical power distribution facilities along and across CR 2548 in Pct 2 with the usual stipulations.

8699 On the motion by Green, second by Martin, the Court approved the final plat for Cattlelack Ranch Estates in Pct 2 presented by Sam Havens.

8700 On the motion by Martin, second by Thornton, the Court approved road improvement of 1.1 mile of gravel road to oil top on CR 3608 in Pct 3 with no payments to Escrow.

8701 On the motion by Martin, second by Green, the Court approved request of FEC Electric to construct electrical power distribution facilities along and across CR 3107 in Pct 3 with the usual stipulations.

8702 On the motion by Martin, second by Green, the Court approved request of FEC Electric to construct electrical power distribution facilities along and across CR 3410 in Pct 3 with the usual stipulations.

8703 On the motion by Latham, second by Thornton, the Court approved request of FEC Electric to construct electrical power distribution facilities along and across CR 4809 in Pct 4 with the usual stipulations.

8704 On the motion by Martin, second by Latham, the Court approved the bid on Box Culverts received from Yoder Construction in Paris. All bids on file in Personnel Office.

8705 On the motion by Martin, second by Green, the Court approved bid received from Yoder Construction in Paris for Clear Span Bridges. Bid on file in Personnel Office.

8706 On the motion by Green, second by Martin, the Court approved part time funding for the month of June in the District Clerk's Office in the amount of \$2,500.00 plus

benefits (at the request of Judge Beacom), to be paid to Stacy Landrum due to Ann Prince's retirement. To be paid through line item transfer from contingency funds.

8707 On the motion by Martin, second by Thornton, the Court approved implementation of the new Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA) which has been federally mandated, requiring counties to get proper training in dealing with personnel privacy issues in connection with electronic billing. At a later date, the Court will appoint someone to carry out all of the rules of the official privacy contact person.

8708 On the motion by Martin, second by Green, the Court approved request from the County Auditor for Hunt County to establish and fund a comprehensive program for the collection of fines and court costs at the District, County, and JP level. Agreement was made for the Auditor and 2 Commissioners to meet with each elected official to discuss the feasibility of this idea. To report back to Commissioners Court with results of these discussions.

8709 On the motion by Martin, second by Thornton, the Court approved contract with Cliff Clottey to assist Hunt County in the valuation of the county roads and bridges as per the new Financial Reporting Model established by the Governmental Accounting Standards Boards (GASB 34). Agreement was made by the Court to pay Mr. Clottey his services up to this point - \$1,410.24. Agreement was also made for the County Auditor to work with Mr. Clottey on a target calendar for specific meetings with the Commissioners and the Court to allow future combined payments to Mr. Clottey for fees, mileage and postage.

8710 On the motion by Martin, second by Latham, the Court approved accounts payable.

WHEREAS, communities must make every effort to promote programs that benefit children and their families;


WHEREAS, effective child abuse prevention programs succeed because of partnerships among agencies, schools, religious organizations, law enforcement agencies, and the business community; and

Hunt County Courthouse and Tax Office Annex

This policy identifies the different color levels of increase security for the Hunt County Courthouse and the Tax Office Annex. The color levels are based on the <u>Risk of Terrorist Acts</u> or <u>Threats</u> as adopted by United State Department of Homeland Security.

Readiness Level Low or Green Low risk of terrorist attacks

The security for this level would be normal, as outline in each department Standard Operating Procedures (SOP)

Readiness Level Guarded or Blue General risk of terrorist attacks

The security for this level requires each department head have their employees increase their awareness for unusual activity or persons in their work area. Suspicious activities or persons are to be reported to the Hunt County Sheriff's Office immediately.

The security for this level requires that three or four times during normal office hours the Hunt County Fire Marshal or one of the Environmental Enforcement Officer make a patrol of the Hunt County Courthouse and the Tax Office Annex.

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The security for this level requires an increase in patrols of the Hunt County Courthouse and Tax Office Annex. This can be accomplished by hiring part-time security personnel to patrol the two buildings during office hours.

Readiness Level Severe or Red Severe risk of terrorist attacks

The security for this level requires that the entrances of the Hunt County Courthouse be limited to the East and West bottom floor doors. These entrances will have walk through scanners and be monitored by security personnel during all hours the courthouse is open. Tax Office Annex, be limited to one entrance with the use of walk through scanner and or monitored by security personnel during all hours the Tax Office Annex is open.
