

COMMISSIONERS COURT
REGULAR SESSION
April 25, 2005

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00A.M. with all Commissioners present with Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as submitted.

NEW BUSINESS:

9409 On the motion by Jim Latham, second by Phillip Martin, the Court approved Joe Milligan as new board member for the Hunt County Committee on Aging. Mr. Milligan is a Commerce, Tx. resident and an investment counselor. *See Attachment.*

9410 On the motion by Latham, second by Kenneth Thornton, the Court approved transferred a 1996 Ford Pick up Vin # 1FTEX14NOTKA25664 from Maintenance Department to Environmental Enforcement Department.

9411 On the motion by Ralph Green, second by Latham, the Court approved removal of a 1991 Ford Vin # 1FACP5043MA155043 from the 354th District Court inventory, to be discarded as the Commissioners Court sees fit. Request was also made for an additional vehicle when available.

9412 On the motion by Green, second by Martin, the Court approved appointment of Dr. Grady McMahan as Hunt County's Local Health Authority Director. *See Attachment.*

9413 On the motion by Latham, second by Martin, the Court approved Quarterly Report for the Hunt County Children's Museum presented by Cathy Sorrells.

9414 On the motion by Green, second by Thornton, the Court approved the Quarterly Report from the Audie Murphy / American Cotton Museum presented by Adrien Witkofsky.

9415 On the motion by Judge Bobbitt, second by Martin, the Court approved the Quarterly Investment Report for Hunt County presented by County Treasurer – Delores Shelton.

9416 On the motion by Martin, second by Latham, the Court approved renewal of Jefferson Pilot Life Policy for 2 years for County employees with no increase.

9417 On the motion by Thornton, second by Green, the Court approved replat of Pecan Meadows, Phase 1 in Pct 1, presented by Steve Martin. Commissioner Thornton stated original plat sent road through a large pond.

9418 On the motion by Thornton, second by Martin, the Court approved road upgrade of dirt to rock on CR 2152 in Pct 1. Commissioner Thornton stated clause of partial payment on upgrade to be made by the individual and part by the County. For: Thornton, Martin, and Latham. Against: None. Abstained: Green. Motion carried.

9419 On the motion by Thornton, second by Green, the Court approved request to upgrade CR1020, CR1022 and CR1023 from dirt to oil sand in Pct 1. Money deposited into Escrow account.

9420 On the motion by Green, second by Martin, the Court approved construction of electrical power distribution facilities along and across CR2522, CR2176 and CR2260 in Pct 2, with the usual stipulations.

9421 On the motion by Martin, second by Latham, the Court approved the Final Plat for the Villages of Lone Oak Phase IV – The Meadows in Pct 3 presented by Rich Jennings – Lone Oak Development and Bobby Stovall.

9422 On the motion by Latham, second by Martin, the Court approved approximately 1950 ft. of road upgrade of dirt to rock on CR4519 in Pct 4, with the usual stipulations. Money deposited into Escrow Account.

9423 On the motion by Judge Bobbitt, second by Martin, the Court accepted bid for evaluation for Commercial Gasoline Card Reader, action to be taken next Court – OLD BUSINESS. Bid on file in Personnel Office.

9424 On the motion by Martin, second by Green, the Court approved bid for Road Oil from Bryan and Bryan Asphalt in Henderson, Texas. Bid on file in Personnel Office.

9427 On the motion by Green, second by Latham, the Court approved line item budget transfers.


