

**COMMISSIONERS COURT**  
**REGULAR SESSION**  
*June 27, 2005*

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00A.M. with all Commissioners present with Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as submitted.

NEW BUSINESS:

**9459** On the motion by Phillip Martin, second by Kenneth Thornton, the Court approved report from the Hunt County Historical Commission presented by Carol Taylor.

— ‘Discuss and possibly take action on notice of eligibility for Hunt County to apply for low interest emergency loans.’ The Court took notice, with no action taken.

**9460** On the motion by Ralph Green, second by Martin, the Court approved request of FEC Electric to construct electrical distribution facilities along and across CR 2526 in Pct 2, with the usual stipulations.

**9461** On the motion by Jim Latham, second by Martin, the Court approved preliminary plat for Rancho Fin Palomas in Pct 4, presented by Frank Owens.

**9462** On the motion by Green, second by Martin, the Court approved the preliminary plat for Oak Creek Estates in Pct 2.

**9463** On the motion by Martin, second by Latham, the Court approved 12 hours of continuing education for Hunt County Judge Joe Bobbitt. *See Attachment.*

— ‘Public discussion on the Hunt County Fair Agreement – Judge Bobbitt.’ Several interested citizens were present to discuss this issue. The Court heard from Ann Groody – Boy Scouts, Donna Helvey – Rodeo Association, Lee Day – Rodeo Photographer, Jake Wiggins, Leonard Threlkeld – Hunt County Horse Association, Frank Jandra – KGVV and Sandra Sally, all of which, was in favor of Hunt County getting more involved with the Horse industry and by using the Fair ground arena.

**9464** On the motion by Green, second by Martin, the Court approved the renewal of 10 years lease agreement (extend to July 10, 2015) with the Hunt County Fair Board. The Court stated they were satisfied with the management of the Fair Board.

**9467** On the motion by Green, second by Martin, the Court line-item budget transfers.


