

**COMMISSIONERS COURT**  
**REGULAR SESSION**  
*December 12, 2005*

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00 AM. All Commissioners were present with Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as presented with change added to Personnel and Payroll.

NEW BUSINESS:

**9653** On the motion by Kenneth Thornton, second by Ralph Green, the Court revoked the Final Plat for Vista Meadows Addition originally approved on November 14, 2005, but never filed; the Court approved the newly submitted plat for Vista Meadows Addition in Pct 1.

**9654** On the motion by Phillip Martin, second by Jim Latham, the Court authorized Judge Bobbitt to dispose of 2 used trailers, which had been moved to Fairgrounds for Katrina victims due to no bids received by Personnel Department.

ADDENDUM:

**9655** On the motion by Green, second by Thornton the Court approved the Final Plat for Harvest Bend Estates in Pct 2, presented by Cliff Jones.

HEAR AND DISCUSS REPORTS:

Judge Bobbitt stated the County is in disagreement with the City of Greenville concerning \$158,000 amount due to the Animal Shelter, after amount already approved in Budget. City Manager Karen Daily has dissolved the Board. Furthermore Judge said, the Mayor and Council members of Quinlan and West Tawakoni are interested in facilitating an animal control plan in the south part of the County. Judge Bobbitt has contacted the SPCA of Texas Judge expects the Interlocal Agreement with Greenville to be cancelled. Agreement was made by the Court to send prorated amount to City of Greenville for December 2005. Judge Bobbitt feels we can have a more efficient means of controlling the animal control issue by using the Quinlan facility in south part and the Commerce facility in the north part of the County.

Mike Lewis of the Kingston area was present to discuss his concerns over holiday fireworks, since our County is still under a Burn Ban, due to no rain. Judge Bobbitt stated Bryan Williams says we have an enforcement problems. Sheriff's Office no longer dispatch to burn calls. At present we are trying to work through the Fire Marshall to get

citation powers. Fire Chiefs do not have the authority to issue a ticket. The Court agreed to look over statues and possibly call an Emergency Session.

**9656** On the motion by Martin, second by Latham, the Court approved accounts payable. Judge Bobbitt abstained from the vote.

— There were no line item budget transfers.
