11,575 On the motion by Larry Middlebrooks, second by Kenneth Thornton, the Court approved the minutes from the meeting held June 14, 2010

NEW BUSINESS:

11,576 On the motion by Ralph Green, second by Middlebrooks, the Court approved the Eagle Scout Project for Caleb Donningsworth to educate the troop on proper flag etiquette. Mr. Donningsworth announced to the Court, there would be a flag retirement ceremony at the Greenville Sports Center at 4:30 P.M. on July 10, 2010.

11,577 On the motion by Latham, second by Middlebrooks, the Court accepted the 2009 Hunt County Audit Report as presented by Robert Lake at Budget Hearing on June 21, 2010.
