The Hunt Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00 A.M. in the Commissioner's Courtroom with Commissioners' Thornton, Middlebrooks, and Latham present, with Judge John Horn presiding. Commissioner Ralph Green arrived at 10:10 A.M. County Auditor-Jimmy Hamilton and County Clerk-Linda Brooks were present. Melva Hill with the Boys & Girls Club gave the invocation.

11,598 On the motion by Jim Latham, second by Larry Middlebrooks, the Court approved the minutes from the meeting held July 12, 2010.

NEW BUSINESS:

11,599 On the motion by Latham, second by Middlebrooks, the Court approved the Quarterly Report for the Audie Murphy American Cotton Museum, presented by Director-Susan Lanning.

11,600 On the motion by Latham, second by Middlebrooks, the Court approved the Quarterly Report for the Boys & Girls Club of Northeast Texas, presented by Director-Melva Hill.

11,601 On the motion by Judge Horn, second by Middlebrooks, the Court approved new curriculum update by the V G Young Foundation for 4-H County Government Program "Key to the Courthouse" to be used at the Middle School and High School, presented by Kyle Gronewald, AgriLife Extension Agent of Hunt County. This new program developed by the County Judge's and Commissioner's Association has the justice system, primary services offered by the County, how every level work together in Hunt County and the Elections process.

11,602 On the motion by Latham, second by Middlebrooks, the Court approved an on-site sewage/land variance request for a septic system for Clara Reynolds in Pct 4 from the 1.5 acre rule, due to only having 1.01 acres, with the location of 2138 McKenzie Drive, Campbell, Texas, presented by Joe Lilly, R.S. 11,607 On the motion by Latham, second by Middlebrooks, the Court approved pass through grant from the USDA Rural Development Facilities Loan and Grant Program for the Commerce Community Garden in the amount of \$36,740.00, to provide an educational facility and a fence around the garden. This project has been supported by the citizens of Commerce, the University and the City of Greenville. Commissioner Latham introduced members of the Community Garden Group Carolyn Thompson, Trey Bowels, Dr. Donna Dudmeyer Odom, and Mike Odom to the Court.

11,608 On the motion by Green, second by Thornton, the Court approved request of FEC to construct electrical power distribution facilities along and across CR 2508 in Pct 2, with the usual stipulations.

11,609 On the motion by Green, second by Thornton, the Court approved the Quarterly Investment Report for Hunt County, presented by County Treasurer-Delores Shelton.
