WHEREAS, the HUNT COUNTY; WOLFE CITY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT; CITY OF WOLFE CITY, HUNT MEMORIAL HOSPITAL DISTRICT and HUNT COUNTY STATE OF TEXAS became, pursuant to a Sheriff's sale for delinquent taxes, the owner of a certain tract of land described in the, attached Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein;

And WHEREAS, because the property described is not currently on the tax roll and will not be added to the tax roll until it is sold, it is desirable that the property be sold so that it may be added to the tax roll and so that the taxes may be assessed against the property in the future;

And WHEREAS, an offer has been made to purchase the property, and the County of Hunt acting on behalf of itself and as Trustee for WOLFE CITY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT; HUNT MEMORIAL HOSPITAL DISTRICT, CITY OF WOLFE CITY and HUNT COUNTY STATE OF TEXAS wishes to accept the offer of Michael L. Harpert to purchase the property for \$1,440.00;

And WHEREAS, the County of Hunt believes a sale for this price is in the best interest of the District.

And WHEREAS, the funds received pursuant to this sale shall be distributed according to the Texas Property Tax Code, and shall constitute payment in full of all taxes, penalties and interest due all taxing entities herein named.

Be it therefore RESOLVED that the County of Hunt hereby authorizes John Horn, County Judge to sign the Deed without Warranty on behalf of the COUNTY OF HUNT, and as Trustee for WOLFE CITY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT; CITY OF WOLFE CTIY, HUNT MEMORIAL HOSPITAL DISTRICT and HUNT COUNTY STATE OF TEXAS.

**LAKES REGIONAL MHMR CENTER
INTERLOCAL COOPERATION CONTRACT**

THIS INTERLOCAL COOPERATION CONTRACT is entered into by and between the agencies shown below as Contracting Parties, pursuant to the authority granted and in compliance with the provisions of "The Interlocal Cooperation Act", Texas Government Code Chapter 791.

I. CONTRACTING PARTIES:

The Performing Agency: Lakes Regional MHMR Center
The Receiving Agency: Hunt County, Texas

II. STATEMENT OF SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED BY THE PERFORMING AGENCY:

Utilize designated county funds to build capacity and develop substance abuse services within Hunt County. County funds are utilized to start services immediately while alternative funding is sought – (i.e. NorthSTAR). County funding designated for substance abuse also supports ongoing services for those individuals not eligible for NorthSTAR and other funding. For FY –10 particular emphasis will be on expansion of services for children and adolescents. Services include the following:

- A. Screening, Evaluation and Intake services for clients seeking substance abuse outpatient services.
- B. Supportive Outpatient Program Services - Adults
- C. Intensive Outpatient Program Services - Adults
- D. Supportive Outpatient Program Services – Adolescent
- E. Intensive Outpatient Program Services – Adolescent

Lakes Regional MHMR will provide quarterly reports to the County Commissioners Court regarding its utilization of funds designated for substance abuse services and the number of clients served. On an annual basis an estimated 293 consumers will receive these services.

III. STATEMENT OF SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED BY THE RECEIVING AGENCY:

Lakes Regional MHMR Center will be scheduled to report to the Commissioners Court at the first scheduled Commissioners Court meetings in January, April, July and October of each year this contract is in effect.

IV. BASIS FOR CALCULATING REIMBURSABLE COSTS:

In consideration of the delivery of services as described above, the receiving agency agrees to the following:

- A. Monthly payment of \$4,167.00 for local matching funds as a sponsoring agency of Lakes Regional MHMR Center for Hunt County.
- B. Payment is for support, development and provision of substance abuse services to Hunt County residents.

V. CONTRACT AMOUNT:

The total amount of this contract shall not exceed \$50,000.00 per year.

PAYMENT FOR SERVICES:

Payments for services performed shall be paid monthly.

Payments received by the Performing Agency shall be credited to its current appropriation item(s) or account(s) from which the expenditures of that character were originally made.

VI. TERM OF CONTRACT:

The Contract is to begin **09/01/09** and shall terminate **08/31/10**. There is an option to renew for additional months or years if agreed to by both parties.


Either party may terminate this agreement upon giving thirty (30) days written notice to the other party. Following written notification of intent to terminate and until the agreed upon date of termination, **performing agency** will continue to have the responsibility to provide services under this Contract and **receiving agency** will continue to have the responsibility to pay for the services in the manner specified in this Contract.

THE UNDERSIGNED CONTRACTING PARTIES do hereby certify that, (1) the services specified above are necessary and essential for activities that are properly within the statutory functions and programs of the effected agencies, (2) the proposed arrangements serve the interest of efficient and economical administration, and (3) the services, supplies, or materials contracted for are not required by Section 21 of Article 16 of the Constitution of Texas to be supplied under contract given to the lowest bidder.

RECEIVING AGENCY AND ITS AGENCY further certify that it has the authority to contract for the above services by authority granted in Title 7, Chapter 534; Texas Health and Safety Code and Current Appropriations Act.


