RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF THE COUNTY OF HUNT, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF RURAL AFFAIRS FOR THE TEXAS STEP FUND; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of the County of Hunt desires to continue to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Hunt to apply for funding under the 2010 Texas Community Development Block Grant Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF THE COUNTY OF HUNT, TEXAS:

1. That a Texas Community Development Block Grant Program application for the TEXAS STEP FUND is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the County with the Texas Department of Rural Affairs.
2. That the County's application be placed in competition for funding under the TEXAS STEP FUND.
3. That the application be in an amount not to exceed \$350,000 of grant funds to carry out water system improvements.
4. That the Commissioners Court directs and designates the County Judge as the County's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the County's participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program.

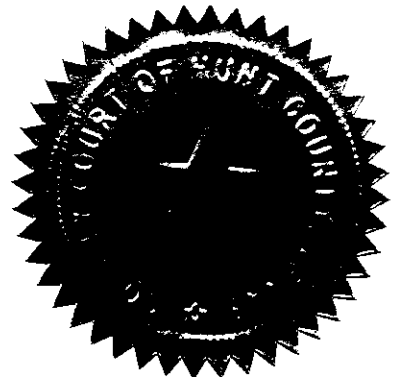



WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Conservation Service has established an important conservation partnership with farmers and ranchers in Texas; and,


