



単12,029 TOBACCO GRANT INFORMATION

Purpose of the grant is to make sure that local vendors do not sell tobacco products to minors. This is a 3 step process:

- 1) An officer makes contact with the store manager and gives them a new packet of signs, the laws, and other helpful material. The officer then informs the store manager that the Sheriff's Office will be making 2 more visits in the next several months, one to check their signs, and one to send in a minor to attempt to buy tobacco products.
- 2) Officers will go to the selected stores (same ones that were previously visited) and check for sign violations.
- 3) An officer will enter the store to make a small purchase, then the minor decoy will go in and attempt to make a tobacco purchase. The minor cannot lie, and has to produce an ID if he/she has one and tell the truth about their age if asked. After the attempt or actual buy is made, the officer makes his/her purchase and leaves. At some point, later in the day or the next day, if a sale was made to the minor, a uniformed officer will issue a citation to the clerk that made the sale.

The goal is to try to keep the vendors in Hunt County selling at a rate lower than 20%.

The first year of the grant, the sale rate was 19.2%.

This year, so far, the sell rate has been 12.5%

At the conclusion of the operation, an officer will take a CERTIFICATE OF APPRECIATION to the stores that do not sell.

Although the Texas STEP program notified us that we would not get any additional grant funds for the next year, because of our success rate, the State Comptrollers office has chosen to pick us up as we have had such a good success rate.
