## BETWEEN COUNTY OF HUNT, TEXAS AND COUNTY OF FANNIN, TEXAS

This agreement is made this 13<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2013 between the County of Hunt, Texas and County of Fannin, Texas.

Pursuant to the authority granted by the "Texas Interlocal Cooperation Act," Chapter 791 Texas Government Code providing for the cooperation between local governmental bodies, the parties hereto, in consideration of the premises and mutual promises contained herein, agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the contract is made under the authority of Sections 791.001-791.035 of the Texas Government Code; and,

WHEREAS, the parties, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder shall make that performance or those payments from current revenues legally available to that party;

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of each party find that the subject of this contract is necessary for the benefit of the public and that each party has the legal authority to perform and to provide the governmental function or service which is the subject matter of this contract; furthermore, the governing bodies find that the performance of this contract is in the common and best interest of both parties; and that the division of cost fairly compensates the performing party for the services under this contract.

I,

Fannin County hereby makes, constitutes and appoints Hunt County its true and lawful purchasing agent for the purchase of Road Oil Contract. Hunt County will forward a copy of requested Annual Contract for the requesting entity use. Fannin County agrees that Hunt County shall serve as the purchasing agent for selected items, and agrees that the bidding shall be conducted by Hunt County according to its usual bidding procedures and in accordance with applicable State statutes.



Fannin County agrees that all specifications for selected items shall be determined by Hunt County.

III.

Fannin County agrees to pay the supplier for all goods, equipment and products pursuant to this agreement. The successful bidder or bidders shall bill the Fannin County directly for all items purchased, and Fannin County shall be responsible for vendor's compliance with all conditions of delivery and quality of the purchased items.

IV.

Fannin County shall protect, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Hunt County and its representatives, officers, directors, agents, employees, county commissioners, and county judges, etc., from and against any and all claims, demands and causes of action that arise out of or are related to this agreement.

V.

Jill Holmes, Purchasing Agent is hereby designated as the official representative to act for the Fannin County in all matters relating to this agreement.

VI.

This agreement shall take effect upon execution by both signatories.

VII.

This agreement shall be in effect from the date of execution until terminated, by either party to the agreement, upon written thirty (30) days notice, prior to cancellation, from one party to the other.


