
1. Condition of each road, culvert and bridge in the precinct:
 - a. **Culverts:** The majority are in good condition. Approximately 15-20% are in need of replacement or drainage along County Roads would benefit from replacement.
 - b. **Bridges:** All are in good condition except for the bridge on CR 1031, which is scheduled to be replaced by TxDOT this year, weather and conditions permitting.
 - c. **Roads:** 236.459 total miles of roads. 52.323 are dirt, 129.832 are rock, and 53.144 are oil sand. Most roads are in good condition (with regular maintenance) but are being pressured by increased traffic as a result of development. Many rock roads needs to be upgraded to oil sand to accommodate additional traffic.
2. Amount of money necessary for maintenance of the precinct roads during the next fiscal year: \$3 million.
3. Number of traffic control devices in the precinct defaced or torn down: There are numerous traffic control devices down or missing due to vandalism or theft.
4. Any new road that should be opened in the precinct: None at this time.
5. Any bridges, culverts or other improvements necessary to place the precinct roads in good condition and the probable cost of the improvements: None at this time.
6. Primary cause of any road, culvert or bridge degradation if reasonably ascertained: Significant development and a resulting increase in habitation has significantly increased traffic by residents' vehicles and heavy vehicles that provide service and delivery to the new residences. Initial construction of new residences in particular causes much damages to roads that needs to be repaired to maintain good condition. Additionally, there is a continued increase in "cut-through" traffic on roads that are not designed to facilitate a heavy traffic load. Additionally, significant new development has contributed to challenges with achieving proper drainage along county roads, creating a need for additional maintenance, repairs, and engineering.

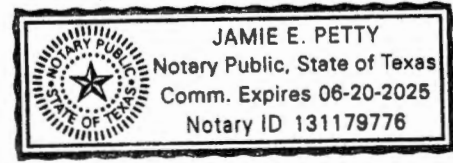

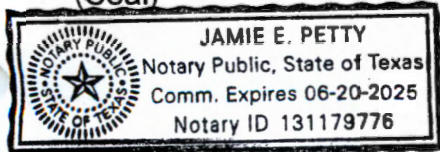

6. Primary cause of any road, culvert or bridge degradation if reasonably ascertained: Increase population, Increase traffic Heavy Equipment, New Residential Plots

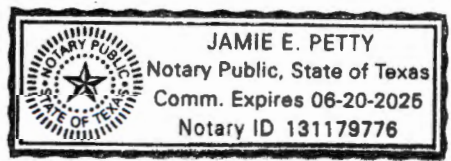

Culverts – 31 Need Replaced

Bridges – No Current Issues (Having A 40ft Bridge Put In Currently On CR 4400)

Roads – Precinct 4 has 298 total county road miles to maintain. There is 82.5 miles dirt, 100.8 miles of rock, 113 miles oil sand and 1.129 miles seal coat/asphalt. Of that approximately 12 miles of rock roads in poor condition. Approximately 14 miles of oil sand roads in poor condition.

2. Amount of money necessary for maintenance of the precinct roads during the next fiscal year:
\$2,150,000.00

3. Number of traffic control devices in the precinct defaced or torn down: 88 miscellaneous signs missing/defaced/damaged.

4. Any new road that should be opened in the precinct: Not At This Time

5. Any bridges, culverts or other improvements necessary to place the precinct roads in good condition and the probable cost of the improvements: Approximately 31 miscellaneous sized culverts need to be replaced.

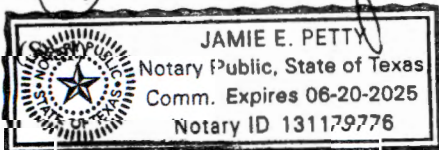

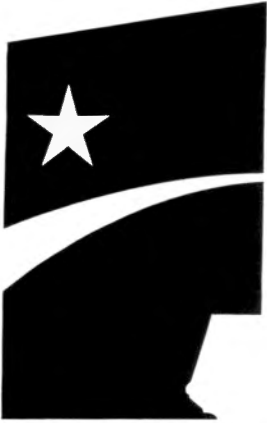

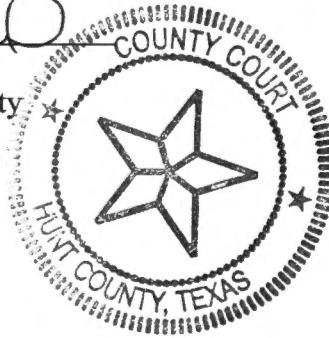
