A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF HUNT COUNTY, TEXAS, REAPPOINTING JEANTTE MOSER TO THE TAX INCREMENT REINVESTMENT ZONE BOARD, AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a seven-member Board of Directors was created to make recommendations to the Greenville, Texas, City Council regarding the administration of the Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone ("TIRZ") by Resolution 09-13 on March 24, 2009; and

WHEREAS, four (4) members were reserved for the City of Greenville, with the other three (3) positions being reserved for the County, School District and Hospital District; and

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2014, by Ordinance 14-073, the Greenville City Council authorized Place 7 as a member for the City instead of the School District since the school district does not approve the payment of part of the tax increment produced by the unit into the tax increment fund for the zone; and

WHEREAS, the Hunt County Commissioners Court is authorized to make appointments and reappointments to the Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone Board pursuant to state law; and


WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that reappointing Jeanette Moser the TIRZ Board is consistent with the interests of the citizens of Hunt County, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF HUNT COUNTY, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Jeanette Moser is re-appointed to the TIRZ Board to serve an additional 2-year term beginning on the last date of her current term; and

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
