I am respectfully requesting funds for the following:

- 1) Purchase of 32 additional poll pads = \$59,175.00 (quotes attached)
 - Includes Software, Annual License and Support Fee, Transport cases, Poll pad Flip Stands, Stylus, Thermal paper for printers, and delivery fees.
 - 32 additional units will allow each polling location to utilize 2 poll pads during each voting cycle to accommodate both in person and curbside voters without discrimination.
 - These are the tablets that voters sign in on during voter check-in process that capture voter signatures and verifies voter data (addresses, precincts, etc.)
 - Additional units will ensure:
 - O ADA compliance: The protection of voter privacy with disabilities and ensure that everyone is receiving the same basic process with regard to checking in at the polling place. It has been determined that every voter must receive the same basic process when checking in at the polling place. Separating curbside voters out from in-person voters by utilizing a paper combination form creates a list of voters who use specific accommodation. Currently curbside voters are navigating a separate check-in process from the process that is provided to voters in the polling place. Additional poll pads will avoid tracking information about voters with disabilities who are requesting specific accommodations in situations where the Election Code does not specifically authorize that information to be tracked.
 - The efficiency of the voting process at each polling location in our rapidly growing county population. 1 poll pad per polling location is currently slowing the check-in process down tremendously at the majority of our polling locations.
- 2) \$41,000 for the addition of 1 full-time employee whose primary duty will be districting the roads our voter database and voter registration clerk. Due to the growth of the county, updating the TEAM database to reflect the county's addressing reports has become a full time job. This employee would also assist with duties to include election worker polling assignments, and other voter duties as needed. Mina Cook resigned in November 2023 and was actively assisting with those duties.
- \$18,000 to cover monthly charges of 40 MiFi units. The "jetpacks" are billed thru Verizon at a government rate and will allow the poll pads to communicate from each polling location back to Voter Administration and to the Vendor. It helps to ensure duplicate voters are detected and alerts Voter Administration to communicate offsite to resolve issues expediently. We've only had 1 month of billing to date. The units were billed at \$37.99 per unit, and the rates appeared to be prorated once the units were suspended. So this is an estimate to cover charges thru September.
